

Wake Up and Go

Small Group Discussion Guide · May 24, 2026

Luke 10:1-2

"The harvest indeed is abundant — there is much ripe grain — but the farmhands are few. Pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

This week's message called us out of tunnel vision and into awareness — God is already at work around us, and He has already sent us to the places He is about to go. The question is whether we are awake enough to move with Him.

Use these questions across one gathering or split them into two. Start with question 1 and let the conversation breathe — the goal is honesty, not answers.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Annie said she heard God say "wake up" — and described it as a loving rebuke.
 - Where in your own life have you been asleep to what God is doing around you?

2. In John 6:5-6, Jesus asked Philip a question He already had the answer to.
 - When has God asked you to do something that felt impossible, only for you to see later that He already had a plan? What did that reveal about your faith?

Leader note: *This is not about having the right answer. Allow silence after asking it. The most honest responses often come after a pause.*

3. Max described arriving in a foreign country alone — no contacts, without the right documents, stuck in a hotel he could not leave. He said he told God: I have no idea what to do. Within days, doors opened through people and connections he never could have arranged.

- Where are you right now facing something that exceeds your ability to solve?
- What would it look like to stop trying to engineer the outcome and just tell God you have no idea what to do?

Leader note: *Give space here for people who are genuinely in hard situations. The goal is not to produce a testimony — it is to practice honesty with God and with one another. Remind the group that Max did not have a plan. He just showed up.*

4. Luke 10:1 says Jesus sent the seventy ahead of Him to places He was about to go.
 - Where do you sense God sending you right now — even if it is just across a fence line, a lunch table, or a work cubicle?
 - If you don't sense a call to go in your spirit, why do you think that is? Are you actively asking the Lord to reveal His will to you?

5. John 7:38 says rivers of living water flow constantly — not periodically.

- What is one thing that tends to block constant flow of living waters in your own life? *Day-to-day family matters? Do your emotions pull you out of the rivers of peace and joy? Etc.*
- And what would it look like for this group to be a source of living water in your family or workplace this week?

Leader note: *Close this question by inviting each person to name one specific place or person they will intentionally bring living water to before next week. Keep it concrete and small.*

John 7:38

"He who believes in Me — as the Scripture has said — from his innermost being shall flow constantly springs and rivers of living water."

Before you close, have each person name one step they will take this week — one place they will go, one person they will serve, one thing they will release. Write it down. Check in next time.
